Colour the cubes using the instructions below

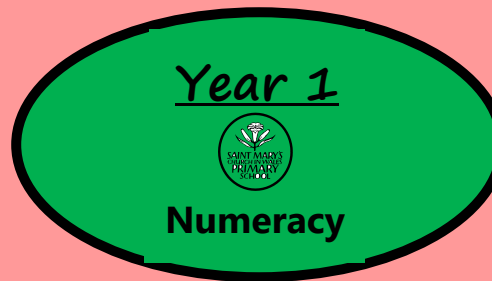


The top cube is blue

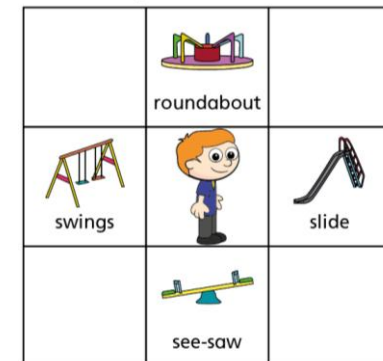
Use the words to help answer the questions

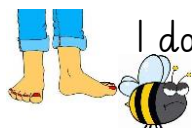

Reading:

Listen to your child read daily. It can be the same book! Use the websites:

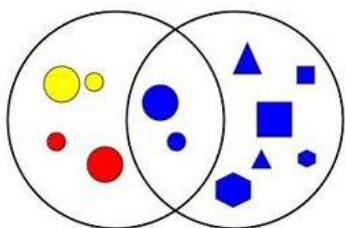
- Oxfords owl
- Collins – big cat
- Play the game free on a computer
- Teach your monster to read
- Read the frequently used words
- Read to your child daily

They should be able to read 90% - 95% correctly

WALT: create artwork in the style of Andy Goldsworthy

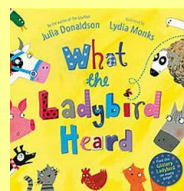
Andy Goldsworthy uses natural resources and objects to create art.

WALT: explore simple city

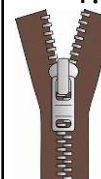
Log into purplemash
