Dough disco

- Use online dough disco videos to aid you if needed. Shonette Basson has lots of online videos, she is the founder.
- Use dough to build models, roll, ball etc.
- We start each day with dough disco as it prepares the children for writing.



Maths

- Use count to a 100 everyday online video.
- Count everyday objects and group them.
- Count in 1's, 2's and 10's both forward and back.
- Measure using standard and non standard units. How many tins of beans long is daddy etc? Estimate and check.
- Number formation.
- Simple sums write some down can they complete them independently?

<u>Language</u>
